VISIT OF DG BSF TO NORTH BENGAL FRONTIER AND INAUGURATION OF HIGH MAST FLAG AT ICP FULBARI

On 11 Feb 2022, Sh Pankaj Kumar Singh, IPS, Director General of Border Security Force along with Smt Nupur Singh, President BWWA arrived at Frontier Headquarters BSF NB Kadamtala for a two days official visit on 11 &12 Feb 2022, Sh Ajai Singh, Inspector General, North Bengal Frontier and other senior Officials welcomed him on arrival at Ftr HQ Kadamtala. Sh Y B Khurania, IPS, ADG (EC) BSF, Kolkatta also accompanied DG BSF to NB Ftr. Inspector General, North Bengal Frontier gave a detailed presentation on emerging challenges and strategy to deal with them. DG BSF discussed the operational and administrative matters with senior BSF Oficers of the Frontier and reviewed the current security scenario & Operational preparedness of North Bengal Frontier. DG BSF virtually inaugurated four 120 men Barrack at Sector Headquarters BSF Kishanganj for better living accommodation of the troops.

Further, Sh Pankaj Kumar Singh, IPS, Director General of Border Security Force inaugurated a high mast flag with a height of 30 Mtrs i.e. appx 100 Feet, erected at Immigration Check Post (ICP) Fulbari under North Bengal Frontier. This is the first time that BSF in Eastern Command is unfurling a high mast National Flag on Indo-Bangladesh border for enhancing the aesthetic value. The high mast flag will be an attraction for tourists at ICP Fulbari. From Bangladesh side, Brig Gen A B M Nowroj Eshan, psc, North West Region Commander of BGB, Rangpur (Bangladesh) along with other BGB senior officials attended the Ceremony. From India side, BSF Senior Officials, local dignitaries and local border population alongwith students and Media persons were also present. A colourful programme and exchange of pleasantries with BGB officials was organised.
